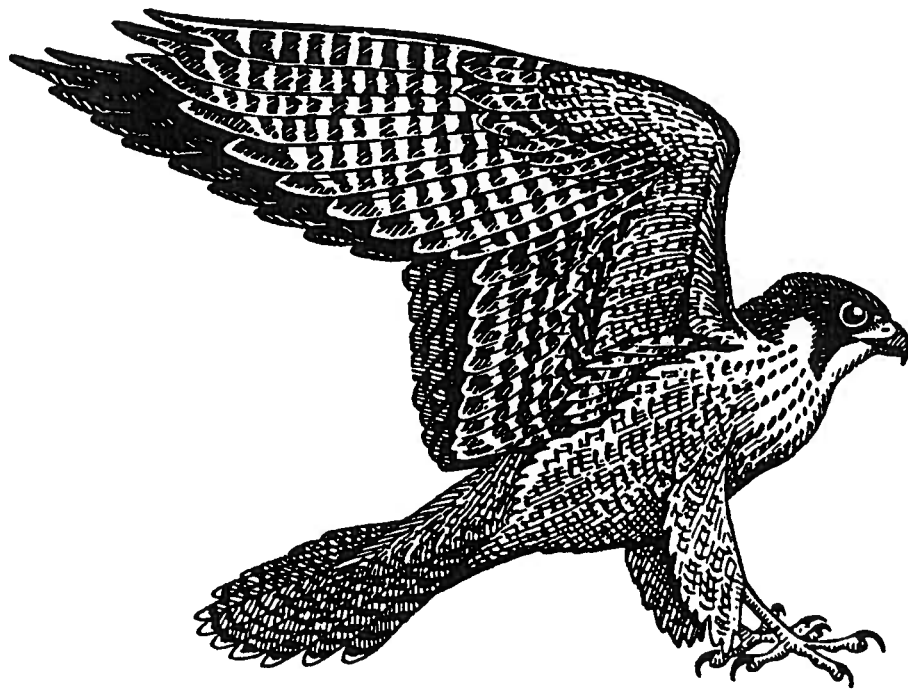

**Dear Kindergarten Parents,**

**The Colorado School Entrance Immunization Law now requires all students to provide proof of immunizations to attend school. This includes a Varicella Vaccine or a history of chicken pox, two MMR Vaccinations, 5 doses of**

**DTap or DPT, and Hepatitis B, which is a three dose series given over a four to six month period. If your child's immunizations are not up-to-date, please contact your doctor to get started as soon as possible. Please inform the school nurse of any missing immunizations and plans for bringing them up-to-date. Tri-County has several immunization clinics available. Their number is 303-451-0123. Please feel free to call the clinic at Red Hawk Ridge at 720-886-3806 with any further questions.**

## Red Hawk Ridge Elementary School

Red Hawk Ridge is on a year round calendar. Therefore, your elementary children will be starting in July. Your child will be assigned to one of four different schedules (called “tracks”). The attached form allows you to request specific tracks for your child. We will do our best to meet as many requests as possible.

### **PROCEDURE FOR TRACK PLACEMENT:**

1. **Mark three tracks in order of preference.** Please do not mark only one or two because we have had to move to second or third choices and we will place children where there is the most space if parent request is not available.
2. We will make every effort to provide as many first and second choices as possible. If we must proceed to your third marked choice, we will attempt to contact you and explain the situation.
3. Unless you specifically request otherwise, all your children will be placed on the same track.
4. Second priority is given to those parents who also have children in middle school. In our research, many of these families are the ones who must make the greatest adjustments in childcare, family time, and vacations.
5. We have attached the four-track calendar as well as the conventional calendar for Liberty Middle School for the 2013-2014 school year.
6. Track selection forms are due to the Red Hawk Ridge office by **4:00 p.m., Friday, March 22, 2013.** Track forms received after **March 22, 2013** will be placed on tracks in order by date and time received at the front office. We will mail track assignments by **April 16, 2013.**
7. Track changes will only be made between school years on a space-available basis.
8. No track assignment is permanent. When student enrollment increases OR decreases, it may require a change in the number of classes per grade level. Therefore, some students' track assignments could be changed.

## **Four-Track Calendar Information Red Hawk Ridge Elementary**

### **Differences in Tracks**

#### **A Track**

- The Red Track
- Four uninterrupted nine –week sessions
- Fewer number of breaks
- Vacations –
  - Three Weeks in September
  - Five weeks in December
  - Three weeks in March
  - Five weeks in June

#### **B Track**

- The Blue Track
- Four uninterrupted nine –week sessions
- Fewer number of breaks
- Coincides with traditional calendar Spring Break
- Vacations –
  - Five Weeks in June/July
  - Three weeks in October
  - Five weeks in December/January
  - Three weeks in April

#### **C Track**

- The Green Track
- Greater number of breaks
- Coincides with traditional calendar Fall Break
- Vacations –
  - Two weeks at the end of June
  - Three weeks in August
  - Three weeks October/November
  - Two weeks for Winter Break
  - Three weeks in January/February
  - Two and half week in April/May

#### **D Track**

- The Yellow Track
- Greater number of breaks
- Vacations –
  - Two weeks at the end of June
  - Three weeks in August/September
  - Three weeks in November
  - Two weeks for Winter Break
  - Three weeks in February/March
  - Four weeks in May

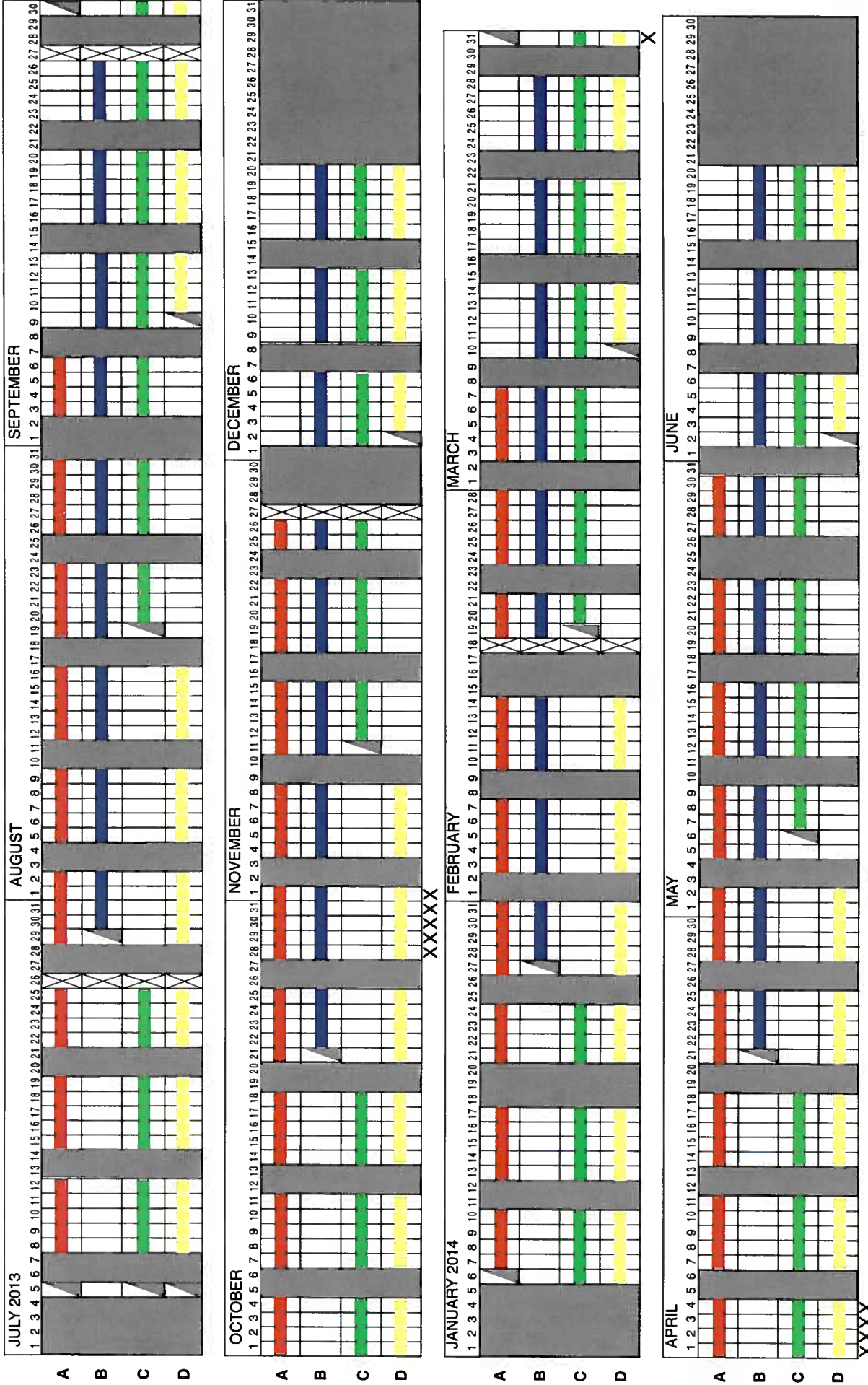

## Kindergarten Enrichment

Kindergarten Enrichment provides an opportunity to participate in high quality academic and social experiences during hours (either morning or afternoon) that the child is not participating in the regular kindergarten program. Children who participate enjoy a variety of activities including reading, writing, math, arts and crafts, indoor and outdoor centers, science, and social studies.

Kindergarten Enrichment is a childcare program that is overseen by the school district but not funded as part of the regular Kindergarten program. Fees are collected on a regular schedule, see the attached fee schedule. THIS IS NOT A PRORATED DAILY FEE. Children attend the program 5 days a week and are expected to attend for the entire session each day.

A sample schedule includes:

Students attend the regular Kindergarten program in the morning, eat lunch and have specials, and then attend the Kindergarten Enrichment Program until school is dismissed.

Students attend Kindergarten Enrichment program, eat lunch and have specials, then attend the regular Kindergarten program in the afternoon until school is dismissed.

### **TO REGISTER:**

Please complete the registration form as early as possible to secure a place for your child. The number of students in each session is limited due to capacity requirements governed by Colorado State Laws. Attach a check payable to Cherry Creek Schools- ECS for \$100.00, which is a NON-REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT, and return the completed registration form and fee to Red Hawk Ridge Elementary School's main office.

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Thank you for your interest in the Cherry Creek School District, **Kindergarten Enrichment**. This program is part of Extended Child Services (ECS), which also includes Before & After School programs and Intersession programs.

Kindergarten Enrichment provides an environment where children can learn, take part in supervised recreation, and build strong, positive relationships with responsible, caring adults and with their peers. Kindergarten Enrichment gives parents and guardians the peace of mind and security knowing that their children are engaged in safe, enriching and constructive activities before or after Kindergarten.

Kindergarten Enrichment monthly tuition is calculated by taking the annual fee of \$2,710.00 for the total number of days students are in school and dividing it by increments to obtain equal payments:

**Traditional/Transitional calendar** - \$100.00 non-refundable deposit is required with registration and 9 equal payments of \$290.00 due the last day of the month, prior to care.

**Year-round calendar** - \$100.00 non-refundable deposit is required with registration and 12 equal payments of \$217.50 due in 3-week increments. Payment is not required while off-track.

Please refer to the 2013-2014 KE Payment Schedule for specific established due dates.

We would love to serve your child in our exciting Kindergarten Enrichment program. This program is available on a first-come, first-served basis. To participate, parents/guardians must complete an ECS Enrollment Form. The non-refundable deposit of \$100.00 is due at the time of registration. This deposit will reserve a space for your child in Kindergarten Enrichment.
